Motion by Brodeen and seconded by Reister to award the bids for unleaded gasoline and gasohol to North Vue Quick Stop for 30 days, the bid for diesel fuel, and heating fuel to D & L Oil Co. for a year and readvertise for bids on gasohol. All voted "aye". Motion carried.

Mayor Bryan gave Ordinance # 247 entitled "1996 Annual Appropriation Ordinance" it's second reading. Motion by Brodeen and seconded by Reister to approve the second reading of Ordinance #247 as read. Roll Call vote: Brodeen, Reiser, VanGerpen all voted "aye". None voted "naye". Absent Knoll and Einrem. Motion carried.

Mayor Bryan presented ^{to} plaques that the City of Avon received for being part of the "Gold" Community organization.




Motion by Reister and seconded by Brodeen to hold a special election on November 7, 1995. (see attached) Roll Call vote: Brodeen, Reister and VanGerpen all voted "aye". None voted "naye". Absent Knoll and Einrem. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Brodeen and seconded by VanGerpen to change the date of the regular council meeting next month to November 9, 1995, so that the council can also canvass the votes from the special election at the meeting. All voted "aye". Motion carried.

Police Chief Luke arrived at 8:10. Luke requested to replace a hand radio which had gotten burned up. Motion by Reister and seconded by Brodeen to have Police Chief Luke purchase a new radio. All voted "aye". Motion carried.

There being no further business to come before the Council at this time, a motion by Brodeen and seconded by VanGerpen to adjourn at 8:20 P.M. All voted "aye". Motion carried.
