Alderman Oster arrived at 8:00 p.m.


After hearing all the appeals the Board of Equalization made the following motion.

Motion by Reister and seconded by Knoll to reduce the valuation of Gary Beeson property from \$18,200 to \$14,176. Roll call vote: Oster, Reister, VanGerpen, Einrem, Knoll, Deurmier and Tolsma all voted "aye". None voted "naye". Motion carried.


