USER FEE:

The user fee will be \$30.00 per team for the summer. This is for any organized baseball or softball teams that will be using the ball parks.

AQUA SIZE CLASSES

Salary to be paid from rate charge. \$4.25 per hour.

EMPLOYMENT CONTRACTS:

Contracts will be signed by Head Lifeguard, Assistant Lifeguards, Baseball, and Softball Coaches, with a \$50.00 penalty clause.

UMPIRES:

The parents are responsible for umpiring the baseball and softball games and if they are not able to, they must make arrangements for someone else to umpire for them.


Motion by Van Gerpen and seconded by Knoll to approve the summer recreation program and to readvertise for Head Lifeguard. All voted "aye". Motion carried.


Motion by Oster and seconded by Reister to advertise for bids on a used road grader. All voted "aye". Motion carried.



Meeting called to order by Mayor Brodeen.


The Board of Equalization determined that all taxable properties had been placed on the assessment roll as prepared by the Director of Equalization.
