Due notice having given, the Avon City Council met as a Board of Equalization on the above date at 6:30 P.M. at the Avon Public Library. Roll call: Mayor Bryan, Auditor Haenfler and Alderman: Einrem, VanGerpen, Knoll, Brodeen, Koehn and Reister. Also present: School Board Representative Jerald Hayward, Director of Equalization Mike Rossiter, Verna Giedd, Marie Nelson and Jim and Angie Martin.

Meeting called to order by Mayor Bryan.

Motion by Brodeen and seconded by Knoll to approve the agenda as presented. All voted "aye". Motion carried.

After some discussion with Mike Rossiter, the Board of Equalization decided to make the following changes in the assessment ledger:


Motion by Brodeen to reduce valuation of Martin's Bar from \$25,298 to \$15,000, seconded by Koehn. Roll call vote: Einrem, Van Gerpen, Knoll, Brodeen, Reister, Koehn and Hayward all voted "aye". None voted "naye". Motion carried.

Motion by Einrem and seconded by Van Gerpen to reduce the valuation of Theodore Koehn property from \$40,530 to \$35,000. Roll call vote: Einrem, Van Gerpen, Knoll, Brodeen, Reister, Koehn, and Hayward all voted "aye". None voted "naye". Motion carried.

Motion by Koehn seconded by Knoll to reduce the valuation of Verna Giedd property from \$27,060 to \$26,060. Roll call vote: Einrem, Van Gerpen, Knoll, Brodeen, Reister, Koehn and Hayward all voted "aye". None voted "naye". Motion carried.


Motion by Koehn and seconded by Knoll to reduce the valuation of Marie Nelson property from \$27,880 to \$26,880. Roll call vote: Einrem Van Gerpen, Knoll, Brodeen, Reister, Koehn, and Hayward all voted "aye". None voted "naye". Motion carried.

There being no further business to come before the Board of Equalization, a motion was made by Brodeen and seconded by Reister to adjourn at 7:55 P.M. All voted "aye". Motion carried.
