

AVON, SOUTH DAKOTA - APRIL 15, 1998

A special meeting of the Avon City Council was held on the above date at the Avon Public Library at 6:30 p.m. Roll Call: Finance Officer Haenfler, Alderman: Oster, Reister, VanGerpen, Einrem, and Knoll. Absent: Mayor Frey and Alderman Deurmier.

Meeting was called to order by Alderman Einrem.

The special meeting is being held to canvass the ballots from the Municipal Election.



Motion by Reister and seconded by Oster that the foregoing tabulation of the Annual City Election be approved and that Daniel Knoll is hereby declared as the elected Alderman of the City of Avon and Edward VanGerpen is hereby declared as the elected Mayor of the City of Avon. Roll call vote: Oster, Reister, VanGerpen, Einrem, and Knoll all voted "aye". None voted "naye". Motion carried. Absent Alderman Deurmier.
