

AVON, SOUTH DAKOTA - MAY 10, 1999

A special meeting of the Avon City Council was held on the above date at the Avon Public Library at 7:30 p.m. Roll Call: Mayor VanGerpen, Finance Officer Haenfler, and Alderman: Oster, Reister, Kuhlman, Den Ouden, and Dertien. Absent Alderman Einrem. Also present were Jack Brodeen and Dennis Deurmier.

Meeting was called to order by Mayor VanGerpen.

Mayor VanGerpen informed the Council he had talked to a resident about their existing curb & gutter. Mayor VanGerpen informed the Council that the City has legal right to take curb & gutter out because it is located in the city right-of-way. Mayor VanGerpen feels the City should considering paying a share of the new curb & gutter for those residence that have existing curb & gutter.

Alderman Oster discussed with the Council that there is newer style curb and old style curb. A suggestion was made to pay a lessor share for those with old style curb & a greater share for those with new style curb.

The Council felt if the City paid for a share of the new curb for residence with existing curb & gutter, that the residence that paid for their curb & gutter would want a portion of there curb & gutter paid for.

Alderman Kuhlman felt that if the City was going to pay a share it should be for those home owners that put the curb & gutter in and not the one that purchased the house with existing curb.


Many other issues were discussed. The Council felt the City could not afford to pay a share of the curb and mat streets. Suggestions were made to proceed as planned. Another suggestion was to discuss it at the regular meeting.

The Council agreed to have Mayor VanGerpen and Alderman Den Ouden contact the City resident Tuesday morning and inform them about what the Council discussed and that the City would proceed as planned.


Alderman Reister left at 8:35 p.m.
