Motion by Reister and seconded by Knoll to approve the agenda with the approval of claims moved to after the re-organizational meeting. All voted "aye". Motion carried.


Motion by Oster and seconded by Deurmier to approve the minutes of the April 7, 15, & 20, 1998 meetings. All voted "aye". Motion carried.
