Mayor Frey discussed the GOLD Community Program with the Council. Mayor Frey suggested that a chairman be nominated to be in charge of anything pertaining to the GOLD Program.

Motion by Knoll and seconded by Reister to appoint Jan Fathke to be chairman for the GOLD Program. All voted "aye". Motion carried.


Streets were discussed. The plan is to turn the following streets to gravel and mat them next year. 1block Oak Street between 2nd and 3rd Avenue, 2 blocks of Popular between Railway and 2nd Avenue, 2 blocks of Walnut between Railway and 2nd Avenue, and 1 block of 1st Avenue between Walnut and Popular Streets. Railway Street will be turned to gravel this year and will be put in the plan for matting a few years down the line.

Mayor Frey requested the regular Council Meeting for the month of August be changed to August 12, 1996. Motion by Deurmier and seconded by Reister to change meeting to August 12, 1995. All voted "aye". Motion carried.


