

ORDINANCE #212

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING SECTIONS 2, 3, AND 4 OF ORDINANCE  
#10 AND AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING PAYMENT OF LICENSE FEE FOR  
PEDDLERS AND TRANSIENT MERCHANTS


Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Avon, South Dakota:

Section 1: That Sections 2, 3, and 4 of the existing Ordinance #10 of the Ordinances for the City of Avon, Bon Homme County, South Dakota, are hereby repealed.


Section 2: Every transient retail peddler shall pay a license fee of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) to do business within the City Limits of Avon, Bon Homme County, South Dakota, and that said license shall be issued at the discretion of the Mayor, or in his absence or unavailability, the President of the City Council and that any applicant for said license shall hold a valid South Dakota State Sales Tax License prior to application for peddler's license.

Section 7: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are to the extent of such conflict hereby repealed.

Section 8: This ordinance shall take effect and be in force twenty days after the passage and publication thereof, once in the Avon Clarion, the official newspaper of said City.
