ORDINANCE NO. 249

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 139 AND REGULATING THE HOURS IN WHICH LIQUOR CAN BE SOLD BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF AVON, BON HOMME COUNTY, SOUTH DAKOTA:

Section 1. Every "on-sale" dealer shall flash the lights of his place of business at 11:45 P.M. each day as a warning that within fifteen (15) minutes his place of business will close. At 12:00 o'clock A.M., every "on-sale" dealer shall clear his premises of customers and patrons and shall lock all doors to the said premises, and shall turn out all lights therein except such a night light as is approved by the governing body of the city. Such night light shall burn from 12:00 o'clock A.M., until daylight of the following day. No "on-sale" dealer may sell, serve or allow to be consumed on the premises covered by the license, alcoholic beverages between the hours of 12:00 o'clock A.M. and 7:00 o'clock A.M., and between 12:00 o'clock A.M. on Saturday night and 7:00 o'clock A.M. on the following Monday morning.

<u>Section 2</u>. No "off-sale" dealer or dealer in High Point beer shall sell any intoxicating liquor or high point beer between the hours of 12:00 o'clock A.M. and 7:00 o'clock A.M. the following day.

<u>Section 3</u>. Section One of this Ordinance shall also apply to "off-sale" dealers and dealers of high point beer, if said dealer operates a pool room, card room, permits any dancing, slot machines, punch boards, game of skill or chance, amusements or any recreation watsoever, whether the same be licensed by the State or not.

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby expressly repealed.
