

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 249 AND
REGULATING THE HOURS IN WHICH LIQUOR CAN BE SOLD

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF AVON, BON HOMME COUNTY, SOUTH DAKOTA:

Section 1. Every "on-sale" dealer shall flash the lights of his place of business fifteen (15) minutes prior to the designated closing time. At 12:00 o'clock A.M. on every Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday and at 1:00 o'clock A.M. of every Friday and Saturday, every "on-sale" dealer shall clear his premises of customers and patrons and shall lock all doors to the said premises, and shall turn out all lights therein except such a night light as is approved by the governing body of the City and shall close his business premises. Such night light shall burn from the time of closing until daylight of the following day. No "on-sale" dealer may sell, serve or allow to be consumed on the premises covered by the license, alcoholic beverages between the hours of closing time and 7:00 o'clock A.M. and between 1:00 o'clock A.M. on Saturday night and 7:00 o'clock A.M. on the following Monday.

Section 2. The governing board may permit the "on-sale" dealer to remain open until 1:00 o'clock A.M. on certain legal Holidays, however, the governing board must give its prior approval for such action at a regular council meeting.

Section 3: Section One of this Ordinance shall also apply to "off-sale" dealers and dealers of high point beer, if said dealer operates a pool room, card room, permits any dancing, slot machines, punch boards, game of skill or chance, amusements or any recreation whatsoever, whether the same be licensed by the State or not.

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby expressly repealed.
